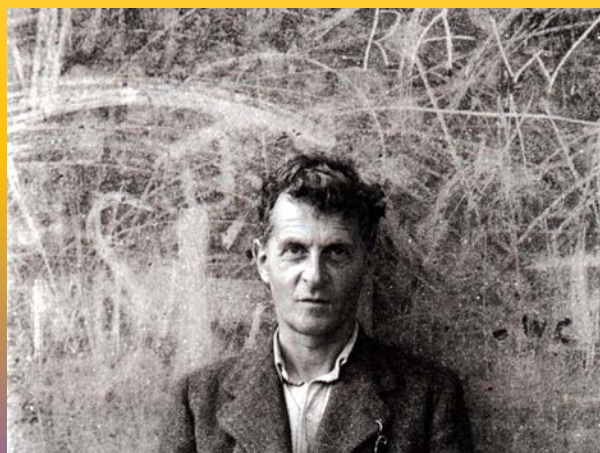

## Citat af den sene Wittgenstein...

It is easy to imagine a language consisting only of orders and reports in battle...But why should I not on the contrary have called a sentence in such a language "Bring me a slab" a *lengthening* of the sentence "Slab!"?

-Because if you shout "Slab!" you really mean: "Bring me a slab" – But how do you know this: how do you *mean that* while you say "Slab!" Do you say the unshortened sentence to yourself? And why should I translate the call "Slab!" into a different expression in order to say what someone means by it? And if they mean the same thing – why should I not say: "When he says "Slab!" he means "Slab!"?"

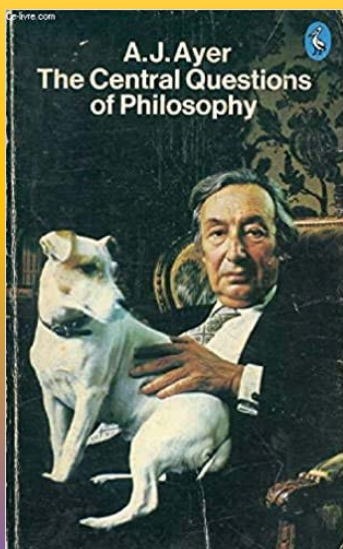

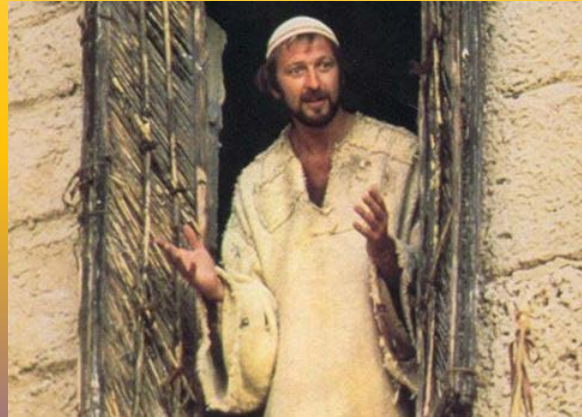
